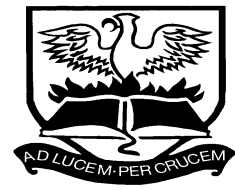

For many years, parents of pupils and Friends of Archbishop Blanch School have very kindly given money to the school. Their generosity is now making a real difference to what we are able to offer, in terms of better resources, better surroundings and better equipment.

Please could you help us?

Any amount you can give, no matter how small, will help us. We would encourage you, if at all possible, to consider giving on a regular basis. If you are able to give us for example £13 each month for 5 years, with the tax we can claim back the school will benefit to the tune of £1,000.

Three separate forms are attached:

- **One-off donations** to our "Special Resources" Fund. If you pay tax, we can reclaim the tax you have paid on your gift from the taxman. This means that every £1 you give is worth £1.28 to us. **Please be sure to fill in the appropriate section on the form if you pay tax:** it makes all the difference!
- **REGULAR** contributions to our "Special Resources" Fund, **don't forget to Gift Aid**, thus allowing the school to reclaim the tax on your donation.
- The **BANKER'S ORDER** form is to set up a **standing order**, so that you can give **regularly** to the school.
- Once you have completed the form(s), please return for the attention of **The Bursar**, ARCHBISHOP BLANCH HIGH SCHOOL, Mount Vernon Road, LIVERPOOL, L7 3EA.
