Dear Student, Parents and Carers

The AS external examinations begin on Monday 16 May. Your daughter/son has already received an examination timetable; this should have been carefully checked and students need to be fully aware of the date, time and venue of each examination.

We would like to draw your attention to the arrangements for the examinations:
Examination will begin promptly at 9:00am and 1:30pm. There will be compulsory preparation sessions before each examination which start at 8:30am and 12:30pm. Details of where these sessions are held are on the attached revision timetable. The preparation sessions will finish 10 minutes before the start of each examination and students will be expected to go directly to the examination venue. When a student has an examination they will be registered in the examination venue; therefore students are **NOT** required to attend morning registration.

All partner school morning examinations start at 9:00am. **Afternoon examinations at St Margaret's and Bellerive start at 1:00pm and at St Hilda's at 1:30pm.** Students must see Mrs Shurie to make taxi arrangements for these examinations.

All students should ensure that they have the correct equipment for each examination. **All other equipment, phones, coats and bags must be placed in a locker before they arrive at the preparation session.** Students will be expected to observe all the examination rules which include entering and leaving the examination room in silence.

All students will attend normal timetabled lessons before and after the examinations. There are however, where possible, additional revision sessions (see attached timetable) before examinations, which students will be expected to attend. After the examinations in any one subject, the lessons will focus on the beginning of the A2 course.

100% attendance is vital and it will be carefully monitored throughout the examination period.

Students have been working hard and have displayed a very good work ethos this year. We would like to wish them every success in their examinations and we are sure they will achieve the grades they deserve.
