ARCHBISHOP BLANCH CE HIGH SCHOOL COVID-19 PARENT CHARTER

This charter sets out the responsibilities of parents to ensure the safety of pupils and staff at Archbishop Blanch during the ongoing Coronavirus pandemic.

1. I will ensure I am familiar with the [Government Stay At Home Guidance](#), school rules and the pupil COVID-19 Student Charter.
2. If my child has Coronavirus symptoms, I will keep them home from school and ensure they self-isolate for a period of at least 7 days. Other members of the household should self-isolate for 14 days.
3. I will inform the school immediately of the symptoms.
4. I must be ready and willing to book a test, provide details to NHS Test and Trace of anyone the child has been in contact with and self isolate.
5. I will provide evidence to the school of the outcome of a test immediately. If the test is negative and my child feels well enough, (i.e no longer has a fever, cough and loss of taste and smell can linger) she can go back to school. If the test is positive, the family must continue to self-isolate.
6. If my child is well, I will ensure they attend school.
7. I understand that transport to and from school is my responsibility and the school has no influence over Merseytravel services.
8. If my child is found with her mobile phone, I understand that it will be confiscated and will only be returned to me at the end of the school day.
9. I understand that school has conducted rigorous risk assessment and implemented all the required measures in line with government guidelines in order to keep my child safe.
10. I must provide a minimum of THREE up to date contact details.
11. I will ensure my child has appropriate equipment for school and understand that resources cannot be shared. This includes a black pen, pencil, ruler, eraser, whiteboard pen, planner, glue stick, coloured pencils, protractor, compass and calculator.
12. If my child has PE, she will wear her PE kit to school until further notice.
13. If my child becomes unwell in school she will be isolated and I will arrange for her to be collected immediately.
14. I will ensure that my child arrives at school on time at 8.25am and follows government guidelines whilst in public, eg wearing face coverings if she is travelling on public transport.
15. I understand that there will be no after-school provision until further notice and that the building will close at 2.35pm.
16. I will ensure that my child understands the importance of following the rules of the school, the new rules in place to keep everyone safe and government guidance. If my child chooses to break the rules, I understand that there will be consequences appropriate to the specific incident in line with our behaviour policy. This may include requiring you to come to school to meet with staff, reflection or exclusion.

I understand the importance of adhering to these rules for the health and safety of all the members of our school community.
