Dear Parent/Carer

Student welfare and the structures provided in school are a key feature of the success at Archbishop Blanch School.

Students are most likely to be successful in school when they attend consistently. Our aim for all students is 100% attendance. If your child will be absent from school, please ensure that you inform the school office no later than 8.30 am. You will need to give the reason for the absence and when we should expect your child to return to school. Each day your child is absent, you will need to inform the school. Further information can be found in the attendance policy on the school website.

Good punctuality at school is essential for students to achieve their full educational potential. It is also vital for students to form good habits for later life. Punctuality records form part of references that will be passed onto employers, colleges or higher educational institutes.

Students who arrive after 8.30 am sign in on late sheets as they arrive in school. From Monday 11th June, parents will receive a text if their child signs in to school after 8.30 am. Students will then have a 10 minute detention at break time. If students are late 3 times in a week, they will have a longer detention of 30 minutes on a Friday at 2.30 pm. If there is a particular issue with punctuality, you may need to attend a meeting in school to discuss strategies to resolve poor punctuality.

High standards of uniform are also an important part of our ethos at Archbishop Blanch. School uniform teaches us to dress smartly and take pride in our school. When students are in their uniform, they are an ambassador for Archbishop Blanch School. On the school website, there is a copy of the uniform policy. I would like to draw your attention to the points on shoes, which should be plain black leather or patent leather only. No plastic style shoes, canvas or trainers are acceptable for school.
