

## Archbishop Blanch Church of England High School

- 1) The name of the school is Archbishop Blanch Church of England High School.
- 2) The school is a voluntary aided school.
- 3) The name of the governing body is "The Governing Body Archbishop Blanch Church of England High School."
- 4) Recognising its historic foundation the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church at parish and diocesan level. The School aims to serve its community by providing education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers all its pupils, whilst respecting and nurturing those of other faiths and cultures.
- 5) The governing body shall consist of
  - a) 3 parent governors
  - b) 1 LA governor
  - c) The Headteacher
  - d) 1 staff governor
  - e) 2 Co-opted governors
  - d) 10 foundation governors.
- 6) The total number of governors is 18.
- 7) Foundation governors, other than the ex-officio foundation, governor shall be appointed as follows:
  - a) 9 foundation governors appointed by the Liverpool Diocesan Board of Education.
  - b) 1 The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor exofficio, Bishop of Liverpool or nominee.
- 8) The Bishop of the Diocese of Liverpool shall be entitled to request the removal of the ex-officio and appoint any substitute governors
- 9) There is a trust deed for the school.



10) The term of office for all categories of governor apart from the Headteacher and any ex-officio governor shall be 4 years. However, governors can at any time resign before the end of their term of office.
11) In line with the School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2013 which replace the schedules 9 & 12 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 and parts of the School Government Regulations 1999 this Instrument of Government comes into effect on 1 September 2015.
12) The Instrument was made by order of Liverpool Local Authority on 13 July 2015.
