SCHOOL PROVIDER ACCESS POLICY

INTRODUCTION

This policy statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. - to hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships through options events, assemblies and group discussions and taster events;
- to understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR ACCESS - A number of events, integrated into the school careers programme, will offer providers an opportunity to come into school to speak to pupils and/or their parents/carers. Please see table of events below.

Year 11 mock interviews:

Employers conduct a half an hour interview with a year 11 pupil. This event is to prepare our pupils for life post 16 and in their future career pathways. The mock interview process helps our pupils learn how to answer difficult questions, develop interview strategies, improve communication skills, and reduce stress before an actual job/HE interview.

Careers Fair:

Our large scale careers fair enables our pupils to gather information regarding their future destinations. We host stands from employers and further education providers. The format of the day gives our pupils an excellent opportunity to look at a variety of career options and higher education pathways, while being able to network and meet representatives of potential future employers. Pupils also have the opportunity to look at various employers regarding school leaver programmes, apprenticeships and NHS traineeships.

These events enable our pupils to learn the vital skills of networking to aid progression within their career.

We use these networking sessions to exchange information and ideas among professionals and our pupils.

Networking aims to build relationships and networks that support the progression to meaningful and secure destinations post Archbishop Blanch School.

Meet the professionals:

We pride ourselves on our Meet the Professional sessions. Throughout our Meet the Professional sessions we endeavor to promote enterprise and entrepreneurship by selecting professionals from across the city, who have a story to tell about their career destination.

Professionals visit our pupils for one hour slots where they present, run a workshop or informally chat to our pupils about the job they do.

The pupil participation is outstanding, these oppurtunities allow the pupils to ask personal career related questions. The sessions are not teacher led, the pupils are in control. The outcome has been measured by pupils asking for certain professionals to revisit the school to talk to larger audiences/subject groups, pupils have been put in touch with volunteer and work experience oppurtunities and have been given practical and useful advice.

Our sessions run for 1 hour on a Wednesday 8.45am-9.45am, please get in touch if this is something you could support our pupils with any of their development choices.
