## **SCHOOL PROVIDER ACCESS POLICY**

### **INTRODUCTION**

This policy statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

### **PUPIL ENTITLEMENT**

All pupils in years 8-13 are entitled:

- to find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point;
- to hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through options events, assemblies and group discussions and taster events;
- to understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

We use these networking sessions to exchange information and ideas among professionals and our pupils. Networking aims to build relationships and networks that support the progression to meaningful and secure destinations post Archbishop Blanch School.</p> <p>If you could offer your time to network with our pupils please get in touch about our next event.</p>	<p><b>Meet the professionals:</b></p> <p>We pride ourselves on our Meet the Professional sessions. Throughout our Meet the Professional sessions we endeavor to promote enterprise and entrepreneurship by selecting professionals from across the city, who have a story to tell about their career destination.</p> <p>Professionals visit our pupils for one hour slots where they present, run a workshop or informally chat to our pupils about the job they do.</p> <p>The pupil participation is outstanding, these opportunities allow the pupils to ask personal career related questions. The sessions are not teacher led, the pupils are in control.
